Key Projects

Utility Management

The objective of this engagement was to analyse the ongoing viability of the Sydney Water Analytical Services and Field Services business units in the context of a wider competitive market analysis and longer term strategic positioning, including any property implications. The assignment was challenging because it involved about ten different groups in Sydney Water and the coordination of many inputs from across the business. The outcome achieved was progressive and practical.

Capital Works Planning

To prepare for the next round of regulatory approvals Southern Rural Water engaged Hunter H2O to review their capital works procedures with a view to improving both their business cases for capital expenditure and to provide some certainty to the rate of spend. The outcome of this review was Southern Rural Water developing a new capital procedures manual, which enabled better development of business cases and ultimately a greatly improved performance on actual expenditure compared to budget.

Economic regulation

With an increasing focus on the sustainability of water businesses within New South Wales, Hunter H2O has worked with Tweed Shire Council to ensure that they are well prepared for any potential changes to economic regulation that may occur. Hunter H2O facilitated a two day workshop with Council working with them to identify areas for improvement across the water business together with a prioritised implementation plan.

Toolondo Water Allocation

Hunter H2O acted as a specialist advisor to Grampians Wimmera Mallee Water, Fisheries Victoria and the Toolondo Reservoir Recreational Fishery Advisory Group to determine how Toolondo Reservoir can be sustained as a permanent high quality recreational fishery either within existing water storage management rules and objectives, by amending existing water management objectives/rules, or through changed operating practices. Hunter H2O facilitated stakeholder workshops and prepared a technical report outlining available options and detailed recommendations for consideration by the Victorian Government.
